Introduction of the speakers

Shaykh Ahmad Arshad holds a B.S. in Computer Science from New York University. During his undergraduate studies, he met Hazrat Shaykh Zulfiqar Ahmad in New York and for over a decade has been blessed to spend extended time with his Shaykh, including accompanying him on many of his travels around the world.

As a result of this deep relationship, Shaykh Ahmad was formally authorized in the science of Islamic spirituality by Shaykh Zulfiqar in 2005. Shaykh Ahmad remains in close contact with Shaykh Zulfiqar and, under his guidance, conducts lectures and programs to assist seekers on the path of purification in the New York City area as well as across the United States. Shaykh Ahmad's weekly dhikar gathering is held at his house on Friday nights. He also conducts regular phone classes and specializes in working with high school and college youth.

Ustadha Humera Ahmad has been a devout student of sacred knowledge from traditional scholars and mashaikh for over a decade. In addition to completing the Aalimah course, she also holds Masters in Economics, Islamic Studies and Arabic.

Ustadha Humera Ahmad also travels extensively around the world including North America in an effort to induce a positive Islamic change in the lives of Muslim women. Alhamdulillah, her non-political and non-sectarian spiritual lectures and seminars have attracted thousands of students and have helped them grow in their deen and becoming closer to Allah [SWT]. She is the principal of Zainab Center in New York and conducts classes on Quranic Tajweed, Quranic Tafseer, Hadith, Fiqh (Jurisprudence), Arabic grammar and conjugation as well as Islamic conduct and mannerism.
